Agenda Item I: Approval of Travel Nevada 3D Project Cohort 4 Selections

Background

- In 2022, Travel Nevada launched the 3D Project—an initiative designed to:
 - o Stimulate economic development in rural Nevada.
 - Improve quality of life for residents.
 - Enhance the visitor experience through tourism-based community planning.
- Since inception, **seven destinations** have successfully completed the process in Cohorts 1–3.
- The 3D Project provides rural communities with:
 - A structured, long-range planning process.
 - o Collaboration with stakeholders, Travel Nevada staff, and consultants.
 - o A **Destination Plan** with strategies for authentic, sustainable tourism growth.
- Following plan development, participants may apply for a share of **\$1 million in** implementation funding to begin execution.

Cohort 4 Application Process

- Pre-Application Site Visits (June 2 July 18, 2025):
 Destination Development Manager Cortney Bloomer visited six communities:
 - Fernley, Lovelock, Beatty, Goldfield, Tonopah, Mesquite.
 Purpose: engage stakeholders, assess readiness, and gather feedback.
- Application Period (July 28 August 15, 2025):
 - o Four applications submitted via Submittable.
 - All applicants had participated in pre-application visits.
- Review Process (August 21, 2025):
 - Applications reviewed by the 3D Project Working Group.
 - Meeting held in-person at Travel Nevada (Carson City) and virtually.
 - Group deliberated and prepared recommendation for the Commission.

Recommendation

Based on application content and expert review by the 3D Working Group, **approval is recommended** for the following Cohort 4 awardees:

- Mesquite Opportunities Regional Fund Mesquite, NV
- Goldfield Main Street Goldfield, NV
